## School Improvement Plan

This year we have been very specific about areas we will be developing, as we want to make a significant difference to the learning for all our children. Our main focus will be reviewing our Maths work in school. As you will know, last year we started implementing Big Maths from P1 - 7 to improve recall of number facts and process, this will continue this school year. We will also be looking at assessing aspects of Maths along with our colleagues in the other schools in our ASG (Hazlehead Academy, Hazlehead, Airyhall and Kingsford Primary Schools and Hazlewood School.) We have a number of joint sessions after school and on Inservice Days where staff will work together ensuring there is a shared understanding of standards. At Fernielea we will also be developing our Technology programme. Miss Thomson will be working on this with the staff, to ensure a clear programme of skills are taught to all our pupils from Nursery to P7. We will be collaborating with the Technology team at Hazlehead Academy. I will keep you updated over the course of the year with our progress.

As part of the curriculum children will be asked to complete some personal study tasks which they will work at both in and out of school.

Homework will start this week. Homework should be an opportunity for your child to practise some of the work they have been doing at school. If your child is finding this particularly difficult, please let your child's teacher know and they can help. Don't allow homework to become a "battleground" at home, give us a call and we can make time to ensure your child is understanding what is expected. Please sign your child's homework jotter and reading record once your child has finished their task. Together we can help your child achieve their potential.

## **Timekeeping**

Our new nursery hours have started, the morning session is 8.30 - 11.40am and afternoon is 12.20 - 3.30pm. Primary school times are 9.00 - 12.15 and 1.00 - 3.00pm. I appreciate that nursery and school times are not the same, but hopefully parents will manage to get children to nursery and school punctually. The nursery children will be doing activities in the cloakroom area after the initial 15 minutes at the start of a session and often may be working in the cloakroom until the last 15 minutes, so I would respectfully ask parents to leave the cloakroom areas once your child is settled and not to arrive too early at the end of the day. It is now ever more important that at the end of sessions parents for both nursery and school are prompt. Staff have meetings after school developing our curriculum and meeting with other staff in other schools. If for unforeseen circumstances you are going to be late **PLEASE** contact the school office. All late arrivals at school and late collections are being recorded.

## **School Website - Class Blogs**

As our new website is fully functioning, staff this year will update you of work going on in each class via the class blogs rather than by class newsletter. Updated information will be posted at the end of this week - please have a look on Friday and find out what your child will be learning this term. If you have difficulty in accessing this please contact Mrs Smith in the school office.

Please remember that the school lunch menu is on the website. If your child is a fussy eater - please check the menu to ensure there is something suitable.

## **School Uniform**

It is great to see almost all our children returning to school looking very smart. Please may I remind Primary School parents that our school colours are green, with a sweatshirt being the main piece of uniform. It makes everything very clear to all the children, we are one team, the Fernielea School team and we all wear the same kit! Please can you make sure that all articles of uniform are named, so that if something gets misplaced we can return it to your child. Packed lunch boxes, water bottles etc should also be named clearly on the outside.

## **Medical Issues**

Mrs Smith will be sending out information updates this week. Please can you check them, make any amendments and return them to school as soon as possible. Please make sure we have any updates on medical conditions for your child. At the end of last term Mrs Angus sent home all medications, inhalers etc, please can you make sure you return them to school along with a new, completed medical form as soon as possible. Thanks
