As yet, there is no replacement so there will be no supervised crossing from Monday28th March.

## Health/Illnesses

There has been an outbreak of Chickenpox in the school, especially in the Early Learning Classes. The most up to date advice from the Health Protection Team is that children who have Chickenpox should stay off school/Nursery for at least 5 days after the appearance of the last crop of spots have appeared and then they should only return if they are well. Often children are unwell prior to the spots appearing.

There is also the usual winter vomiting bugs going around at this time of year. Please remember that there is clear guidance that children who have vomited or have diarrhoea should only return 48 hours after the last episode of vomiting or diarrhoea.
