Primary School Idle Campaign

Aberdeen City Council are due to commence an 'engine idling' campaign which will involve officers from Aberdeen City Council undertaking patrols at schools. Children are more vulnerable to air pollution because they breathe 50% more air per pound of body weight than adults. Engine idling occurs in schools every day when children are dropped off and picked up and this coincides with the time children will be concentrated in these areas.

To promote positive behaviour their officers will approach non-idling drivers and reward them with a small promotional item. This will hopefully reinforce the no idling message to drivers. Idling a vehicle unnecessarily is an offence and their officers will warn any driver found to be doing this. If the driver fails to turn the engine off they may be issued with a £20 fixed penalty notice.

Parental Consultation

At May's Parent Evening, we asked you to comment on the children's Snapshot Jotters which they completed over the course of a week in April. The jotters are an opportunity to gather evidence of your child's progress but they are also a very focused way to develop your child's ability to reflect on themselves as a learner. The children gave the jotters the thumbs up as did the staff. The feedback from parents and carers was as follows:

Did your child tell you about their Snapshot Jotter?	Yes - 41.8%	No - 58.2%	
Did you read your child's Snapshot Jotter?	Yes - 73.7%	No - 26.3%	
Would you like more opportunities with your child, to view and discuss their learning?	Yes - 83.3%	No - 16.7%	
Which format would suit you best?	Online updates via app/link 40.9%	Home 43.9%	School 50%

As you can see the response was very positive. Some responses to what you learned about your child as a result of reading the Snapshot Jotter were:

"It's good to read all about their work and how they are getting on."

"I found out that she is at a very good level in her learning."

"That what she is learning, she is taking in and using throughout her work."

"He is a bit hard on himself when reviewing his work."

We aim to do another Snapshot Jotter every term and share it with you so that we are encouraging families to learn together.
