The cost of this is £260 per pupil. In previous years we have invited families to pay for the trip in monthly installments, but payment must usually be completed around 6 weeks before the trip commences.

We also support families to make applications to the Aberdeen Endowments Fund which can cover up to half of the cost for families who are in receipt of certain financial supports. P7 always fundraise to cover as much of the costs as they can to reduce the price for each pupil and any transport costs.
